

# 2019 Drinking Water Main Improvement Project

## Project Summary:

Beginning later this week or early next week, Capital Region Water's contractor will begin construction work on:

- Laurel Street between Walnut Street and Locust Street
- Locust Street between Laurel Street and 3040 Locust Street
- Herr Street between N 30th Street and Walnut Street
- Walnut Street between Herr Street and Laurel Street

The contractor will be installing new, larger water mains in these areas to improve water quality and service reliability.

Traffic control and partial lane closures will be in place in the project area and you will hear and see construction activity during working hours. Crews will work during the day (7:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday - Friday) while working on Laurel and Locust streets and will work on the weekend (6:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m., Saturday - Sunday) while working on Herr and Walnut streets.

There will be no parking permitted in the project area during working hours until the water main installation is complete. Temporary water shut downs may be required to connect the new water mains. Customers impacted by temporary shut downs will be notified prior to these shutdowns.

**Customers at 3027, 3029, and 3031 Walnut Street will be connected to a temporary service line that will run along the sidewalk to maintain water service during this project.** Crews will work with each customer individually prior to connecting them to this temporary service.

This work is expected to take two to five weeks to complete. When the pipe replacement is complete, the roads will be temporarily patched until final street restoration occurs at a later date.

Capital Region Water will have a representative on site during working hours. No one will request to enter your home.

## Background:

Capital Region Water maintains over 200 miles of water mains that deliver drinking water throughout the City of Harrisburg and portions of Susquehanna Township, Paxtang, and Penbrook.

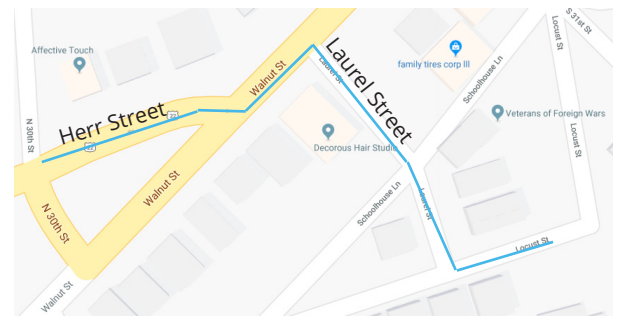
