Recycling, waste and 1 bulk item are collected every Wednesday. Yard waste is collected on the last Wednesday of each month, April through October.

Republic Services observes the following holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. When a holiday falls on a Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday, your collection will be delayed by one day. When a holiday falls on a weekend, there will be no delay in your collection day.

## Service Details

Recycling and waste is collected one time per week on Wednesday. Each residence may set out up to four (4) containers each waste collection day. Containers cannot exceed 32 gallons and may not weigh more than 60 pounds. Additional service bag tags may be purchased through the Penbrook Borough office.

Bulk items will be collected on Wednesday, the same day as recycling and waste. Each residence is permitted to set out one (1) bulk item per week for collection.

### Acceptable Bulk Items Include:

- Furniture
- Mattresses and box springs
- Carpet rolled and tied in maximum of 48 inch lengths
- Washers, dryers and dishwashers
- Other household items too large for regular weekly collection

### Special Handling Items include:

- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Any other appliance with Freon® or other refrigerant

Please call Republic Services® to schedule collection.

### Unacceptable Bulk Items Include (but not limited to):

- Liquids
- Paints and stains
- Chemicals
- Household hazardous waste
- Tires or rims
- Construction and demolition waste

**Brush/Yard Waste** is collected on seven (7) collection days from April through October on the last Wednesday of the month. Yard waste is defined as leaves, tree trimmings and hedge trimmings, and must only be placed in your tan or blue yard waste container. It cannot be in brown paper bags or other containers as we can't determine if it's contaminated. You can also place bundled limbs beside your container if they don't fit. Bundled limbs should not exceed 4 feet in length or 6 inches in diameter. **Grass clippings are not acceptable as yard waste.** Grass clippings will be collected as waste and will count towards the four (4) container waste limit.



## Recycling Guidelines

### Acceptable Items

- Plastic containers with symbol #1, 2 and 5. Must be narrow neck and screw top containers where the base is wider than the neck
- Aluminum and steel food and beverage containers
- Glass: clear, green and brown bottles and jars
- Newsprint
- Cardboard of any size and flattened (packing material must be removed; no food or residue)
- Drink cartons

### Unacceptable Items

- Residential mixed paper (junk mail, magazines, glossies, telephone books, printer/copier paper)
- Cereal boxes
- Window or auto glass, drinking glasses, mirrors, light bulbs, ceramics, porcelain, microwave trays, cookware/bakeware
- Un-numbered plastic items
- Plastic bags
- Salad/deli containers
- Plastics #3, 4, 6 and 7
- Household items such as cooking pots, toasters, etc.
- Batteries
- Cardboard/paper with wax coating or liners
- Scrap metal and siding

### Special Notice Regarding Your Recycling, Waste and Yard Waste Containers:

Please put your address on each of your containers either with stickers, marker or paint. This helps our drivers when we need to replace the container or, for any other, address specific issues.
